**One of the joys of preparing an annual report is that it gives us a chance to look back and to be thankful for all that has been accomplished. The past year was filled with both opportunities and challenges. Some highlights were:**

- Provided a spring educational conference for sheriffs and deputies in April 2010
- Gave an immediate \$5,000 in-the-line-of-duty death benefit to 3 deputies killed in the line of duty
- Awarded 63 scholarships to people throughout Virginia who are majoring in criminal justice at a Virginia college or university
- Provided 2 lawful employment training programs for 100 sheriffs and deputies
- Contributed to the following organizations: National Sheriffs' Institute educational program and the Virginia State Police Association Emergency Relief Fund
- Donated to the National Law Enforcement Memorial Fund to honor Virginia officers killed in the line of duty through its Virginia license plate sales
