One of the joys of preparing an annual report is that it gives us a chance to look back and to be thankful for all that has been accomplished. The past year was filled with both opportunities and challenges. Some highlights were:

- Provided a spring educational conference for sheriffs and deputies in April 2014
- Gave an immediate in-the-line of duty death benefit up to \$5,000 to 2 deputies killed in the in the line of duty to assist in relieving distress in the community.
- Awarded 110 scholarships to people throughout Virginia who are majoring in criminal justice at a Virginia college or university
- Provided 2 lawful employment training programs for 100 sheriffs and deputies
- Contributed to the following organizations: Virginia State Police Association Emergency Relief Fund, Virginia Coalition for the Prevention of Elder Abuse, Inc., Concerns of Police Survivors, Inc. (COPS) and the Virginia Network for Victims and Witnesses of Crime, Inc.,
- Donated to the National Law Enforcement Memorial Fund to honor Virginia officers killed in the line of duty through its Virginia license plate sales
